

## Catch Up Plans

### Key Priorities:

- To work towards no students being below ARE by the end of Year 7
- To ensure all students make good progress in literacy and numeracy from their KS2 data

### Expected Outcomes:

- Early identification through transition visits so early intervention can be put in place.
- Improved levels of engagement which promotes positive behaviour.
- Improved levels of progress to allow them to go to their chosen next pathway.
- Improved levels of attainment to beyond their ME grade.
- Improved levels of attendance to 96% plus.
- Success for all in achieving at least ME grades.

### Pupil Profile:

Y7 - 2018/19 below KS2 benchmark on entry

| English Reading     | English SPAG        | Maths               |
|---------------------|---------------------|---------------------|
| 28.9% (43 students) | 29.5% (44 students) | 30.9% (46 students) |

Y8 – 2017/18 below KS2 benchmark on entry

| English Reading     | Maths               |

### Actions and Interventions:

- One extra lesson a week in literacy and one lesson per week in numeracy to support good progress for those students below ARE
- Enrichment time for identified students in Year 7 and Year 8 to receive intervention
- Reading Army intervention for targeted students – paired reading with 6<sup>th</sup> form volunteers. Baseline reading ages at start and end of interventions.
- Hegarty Maths support

### Monitoring and Evaluation:

- Regular monitoring and tracking of student progress following each data capture
- Analysis of progress and implementation of targeted intervention for those not catching up quickly enough
- Student voice
- Annual evaluation of impact and areas for development
