

Overview Homework at Wednesfield High

At Wednesfield High we recognise the importance of homework in developing students' knowledge and skills beyond the classroom. The setting of regular, meaningful homework will help each child to make good progress and to succeed in their examinations.

Weekly homework will be set in each subject and explained in class. The task will be recorded by the students in their planners. Homework set will either link to the learning in the lesson, prepare students for the next lesson or be revision and exam tasks.

Each piece of homework set will be given a deadline of a week to complete. This will encourage students to plan the completion of homework tasks across the week ready to meet each subject deadline.

In **Year 7 and 8** students are expected to spend approximately an hour a night completing homework. We do not set a homework timetable as we want teachers to set homework at the best time to support the students' learning. The amount of time a student should spend on homework per subject each week is:

Subject	Approximate Weekly Time Allocation
English	30 minutes
Maths	30 minutes
Science	30 minutes
French (if taught)	20 minutes
Geography	20 minutes
History	20 minutes
Creative Arts Carousel (Art, Music, Drama)	20 minutes
Learning for Life Carousel (ICT, Food, RE)	20 minutes
Citizenship	20 minutes
Computing (if taught)	20 minutes
Engineering	20 minutes
Literacy/ Numeracy (if taught)	20 minutes

In **Year 9 students** are expected to spend approximately 75 minutes a night completing homework. We do not set a homework timetable as we want teachers to set homework at the best time to support the students' learning. The amount of time a student should spend on homework per subject each week is:

Subject	Approximate Weekly Time Allocation
English	45 minutes
Maths	45 minutes
Science	45 minutes
All Options Subjects	30 minutes

In **Year 10 and 11 students** are expected to spend 90 minutes a night completing homework. We do not set a homework timetable as we want teachers to set homework at the best time to support the students' learning. The amount of time a student should spend on homework per subject each week is:

Subject	Weekly Time Allocation
English	60 minutes
Maths	60 minutes
Science	60 minutes
All Options Subjects	40 minutes

In **Year 12 and 13 students** are expected to be set an additional 5 hours of study per subject per week and that this is recorded on the academy independent study records.
